- **Information Items:**

- **College Update-Mrs. Frey:** The college mock schedule and the pre-registration forms were due today. She already started the pre-registration and they plan to finish by tomorrow. The Political Science classes and afternoon classes are almost full. There was a lot of students that did turn in the forms but there were still some that didn't turn them in. This semester there were more classes, with new subjects being offered, however they have to work with caution because they are working off a mock schedule. In the end there may be less because of the budget cuts. All the students that are supposed to be enrolled in a Guidance class are registered, excluding nine students that have bad grades.
- **Student Updates-ASB Stephanie Martinez:** ASB doesn't have everything planned for the month of January because they just started school again. However, ASB does have some events planned for the semester. They plan to have four pep-rallies, a Spring Fling in March, Pennies 4 Patients, a Carnival and Battle of the Bands, Prom, and a Study Knight. For the Carnival she was suggested that she work with the Lions Club because they plan to hold an Apricot Festival. The first pep-rally is on January 14, 2011.
- **Principal/Designee Update-Mr. Cornett:** On January 14, 2011 we will have an assembly to introduce new students, superintendent, and to remind the students about the goal from the beginning of the year. Eight students had to leave the school because they were in academic probation for three consecutive semesters. Most of those eight students want to return next school year. A lot of students were removed from Academic Probation but are still in Academic Watch. This happens in the morning and it's so that the students still have the support. The applications for the 2011-2012 school year start on February 5, 2011 and will go on until April 7, 2011. The application will be reduced in size for this school year. Most grades at college are well but, some students did fail. Some students may be reduced from the school because of their behavior at the MVC campus. They want to start planning the school wide field trip for next year. They are offering a new AP Calculus course online and they are offering an AP Government Course in the next two weeks. The students are excited, they can only get credit in High School but students can take the AP test to get college credit also.
- **District Update- Mr. Fowler:** There has been more money spent in Extra Duty than what was expected. The money has been spent because they only budgeted for one period zero

and there's now going to be three zero periods because of this they may have to move money to budget for the three zero periods. There are less AVID tutors this year so we can save money, so now they have extra money. There is \$ 8852.43 that isn't going to be used. We need to hire somebody to continue access to the data base to make Mrs. Frey's job easier. They want to hire the same person they previously had; she would only be working 7 hours for 20 weeks. They have money to update the football fields. It looks promising but not guaranteed. The Riverside Development Agency has kind of agreed to give the school the Sod for free. The school has enough money to get a simple irrigation system. There is still a little extra money in the remodeling section, which can be used for other things depending on how things are prioritized.

- **Technology Subcommittee Report-Mr. Fowler:** We ordered 3 student computers, 2 teacher computers and a computer that has been broken for 10 months in the Art room. They also need a laptop for teacher use. Next year NBECHS wants to become an AVID Demonstration School. They already received the new printers but haven't got the light bulbs and cartridges. The projectors have been running for three years and expect them to be flickering out. There is \$5000 for emergencies.
