### Panama Canal

- 1880-1900 U.S. leading manufacturing country in the world.
- U.S. became world power after taking over Cuba & the Philippines after Spanish American War
- Pro-Business policy ←
- 1896 & 1900 McKinley elected President ←
- He represented opinion of U.S.
- McKinley & Hannah, Mark
- Pan American exposition
  - Buffalo, NY
  - World's Fair (architecture colors, sculptures, show Social Darwinism)
  - racism, social divide ↗
- Acts of anarchy inspired by anarchism
- Shulgosh latched on to anarchist movement



- Anarchist editor writes warning about "spy" (Shulgosh)
- Panamerican Exposition opened Spring 1901
- McKinley cancelled Trip to Buffalo because wife was ill.
- Roosevelt governor of NY.
- Shulgosh fascinated by assassination of King Humbert.
- Shulgosh plans assassination of President
- McKinley arrives in Sept. at Buffalo for exposition. ←
- Sept. 6, 1901
- McKinley was warned about safety of going to event ←
- Temple of Music 4 pm ←
- Shulgosh attended
- Secret Service focused on black man in line instead of Shulgosh who had gun in handkerchief
- McKinley was shot by Shulgosh
